REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS - MUNICIPAL ACCOUNTING/AUDITING **SERVICES**

PLEASE BE ADVISED that the Town of Brunswick is hereby requesting proposals pursuant to law, and its Purchasing Policy, from qualified interested firms, for municipal accounting/auditing services in connection with its financial records, as well as the required annual audits of its Justice Court records, for five (5) consecutive fiscal years, to wit: 2025, 2026, 2027, 2028 and 2029.

The Final Report for fiscal year 2025 shall be completed and ready for presentation to the Town Board by the successful firm at the June 2026 Regular Meeting. The Final Report for the fiscal year 2026 shall be completed and ready for presentation by the successful firm to the Town Board at its Regular Meeting in June, 2027. The Final Report for fiscal year 2027 shall be completed and ready for presentation to the Town Board by the successful firm at the June 2028 Regular Meeting. The Final Report for the fiscal year 2028 shall be completed and ready for presentation by the successful firm to the Town Board at its Regular Meeting in June, 2029. The Final Report for fiscal year 2029 shall be completed and ready for presentation by the successful firm to the Town Board at its Regular Meeting in June, 2030.

The preparation of the Annual Update Document (AUD) for each year of this Agreement shall also be the responsibility of the successful firm.

The annual audit will be made in accordance with the following:

- Generally accepted auditing standards.
- Applicable standards promulgated by the New York State Comptroller.
- Applicable Regulations of the federal government. Applicable Regulations of the Governmental Accounting Standards Board (GASB).

All proposals submitted must include any hourly fee for additional bookkeeping services, if any, which are required in order to complete the annual audits. Proposers must include a copy of their most recent Peer Review Report as part of their proposal.

Other work to be performed by the successful firm at no additional cost:

- Provide telephone, written, or e-mail assistance with general and specific accounting questions as needed.
- Provide guidance on General Accepted Accounting Principles (GAAP) and Governmental Accounting Standards Board (GASB) regulations as appropriate.

An independent audit of the Town's financial records has been conducted for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2024.

In order to be considered, proposals must be received in the Office of the Town Clerk, Town of Brunswick, 336 Town Office Road, Troy, N.Y. 12180, no later than 10:00 A.M. on November 17, 2025. Ten (10) copies of the proposal must be provided in an envelope labeled "Proposal for Audit Services".

Interested firms may obtain a copy of the 2025 Annual Budget free of charge by contacting the undersigned.
