

WATER SERVICE INTERRUPTION NOTICE

The Town of Brunswick Water Department will be repairing a water main break on Brunswick Rd east of South Lake Avenue tomorrow Wednesday February 18, 2026. This will require a temporary interruption in the water service to your neighborhood. The following areas and roads will be impacted Brunswick Rd from 100 to 152 both sides of the road. All side streets from Farnam Lane to Denton Place including Oxford Road, Oxford Circle and Riding Club Area.

The water interruption will be approximately 8 hours long on Wednesday starting at 8:30 AM in the morning.

The Water Department of the Town of Brunswick apologizes for any inconvenience this may cause our customers Please set aside water for drinking and flushing your facilities as required.

There will also be the potential for the water to be discolored from disturbed iron sediments in the water line. Please check your water before doing laundry for discoloration. Flush your water pipes either through a hose spigot or your bathtub faucet.

If you should experience reduced water pressure in your water faucets after water service has been restored, check all faucets by removing the water saver and protective screen on the faucet and rinse out the line, reinstall the water saver and screen after the line has been run for a few minutes. Sediment caught in the screen is the most common cause for reduced water pressure in your home.
