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The Town of Brunswick is adopting an amendment to its Zoning Map pertaining to Tax Parcels 91.-2-26.111 and 91.-2-7.12. The purpose of this action is to correct two errors which were included on the Zoning Map of the Town of Brunswick when it was adopted on June 22, 2017 pursuant to Local Law No. 1 of 2017. The amendment will remove Parcel 91.-2-26.111, totaling 1.66 acres and located at Hoosick Road and Betts Road, from the Berkshire Properties Planned Development District and locate such parcel in the B-15 Commercial Zoning District. Parcel 91.-2-26.111 was not part of the Berkshire Properties Planned Development District, and had been located in the B-15 Commercial Zoning District. The amendment will also remove Parcel 91.-2-7.12, totaling 18.11 acres and located at Skyview Drive and Crescent Lane, from the B-L Business Light Zoning District and locate such parcel in the R-40 Residential Zoning District. Parcel 91.-2-7.12 was the subject of an approved subdivision, and was not intended to be placed in the B-L Business Light Zoning District.
