A LOCAL LAW SUPERSEDING TOWN LAW § 64(11) REGARDING THE DESIGNATION OF THE OFFICIAL TOWN NEWSPAPER OF THE TOWN OF BRUNSWICK AND THE ABILITY OF THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF BRUNSWICK TO DESIGNATE AN ALTERNATE OFFICIAL TOWN NEWSPAPER OF THE TOWN OF BRUNSWICK

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Brunswick as follows:

Section 1. Legislative Intent.

It is the intent of this local law to supersede § 64(11) of the Town Law regarding the designation of the official town newspaper of the Town of Brunswick and the ability of the Town Board of the Town of Brunswick to designate an alternate official town newspaper of the Town of Brunswick to be used for the publication of public notices where use of the Town's official newspaper is not viable due to statutory publication timeframes.

Section 2. Authority.

This local law is adopted pursuant to Municipal Home Rule Law, § 10(3).

Section 3. Supersession.

This local law shall supersede § 64(11) of the Town Law regarding the designation of the official town newspaper of the Town of Brunswick and the ability of the Town Board of the Town of Brunswick to designate an alternate official town newspaper of the Town of Brunswick to be used for the publication of public notices where the use of the Town's official newspaper is not viable due to statutory publication timeframes.

Section 4. Designation of Official Town Newspaper.

The Town Board of the Town of Brunswick may designate as the Town's official newspaper any newspaper of general circulation in the Town of Brunswick without regard to the order or hierarchy set forth in Town Law, § 64(11) provided that the said newspaper meets the statutory definition of a newspaper as set forth in General Construction Law, § 60(a) and Public Officers Law, § 70-a.

Section 5. Designation of an Alternate Official Town Newspaper.

The Town Board of the Town of Brunswick may designate an alternate official town

newspaper to be used for the publication of public notices where use of the Town's official town newspaper is not viable due to statutory publication timeframes. The alternate official town newspaper must be a newspaper as defined in General Construction Law, § 60(a) and Public Officers Law, § 70-a, and must be in general circulation in the Town of Brunswick.

Section 6.     Inconsistency.

All other local laws and ordinances of the Town of Brunswick that are inconsistent with the provisions of this local law are hereby repealed; provided, however, that such repeal shall only be to the extent of such inconsistency and in all other respects this local law shall be in addition to such other local laws or ordinances regulating and governing the subject matter covered by this local law.

Section 7.     Severability.

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision or part of this local law or the application thereof to any person, individual, firm or corporation, or circumstance, shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such order shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation, or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment or order shall be rendered.

Section 8.     Effective Date.

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
