

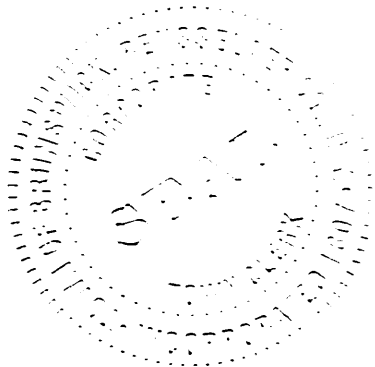

Local Law No. 4 of the Year 2024

A Local Law Amending Section 139-12 of the Town Code of the Town of Brunswick so as to Extend the Eligibility for the Disabled Homeowner Tax Exemption in the Town of Brunswick.

(Introduced as Introductory Local Law No. 4 of the Year 2024)

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Brunswick as follows:

Section 1: Article V of Chapter 139 of the Town Code of the Town of Brunswick provides for a Disabled Homeowner Tax Exemption in the Town of Brunswick in accordance with the provisions of Section 459-c of the New York State Real Property Tax Law. It is now the sense of this Town Board that Article V of Chapter 139 of the Town Code of the Town of Brunswick should be amended to make the said tax exemption available to additional taxpayers as is authorized by the said Section 459-c of the New York State Real Property Tax Law as amended as of the date of the adoption of this local law.

Section 2: Pursuant to Section 459-c of the New York State Real Property Tax Law, Section 139-12 of Article V of Chapter 139 of the Town Code of the Town of Brunswick be and hereby is modified and amended as hereinafter set forth so as to provide as follows:

Section 139-12 Persons with disabilities and limited incomes.

Effective as hereinafter provided, there shall be an exemption from taxation for general town purposes to the extent of the percentage of assessed valuation provided in the following schedule, determined by the maximum income exemption eligibility level also provided in the following schedule up to a maximum of fifty percent (50%) of the assessed valuation of real property owned by one or more persons with disabilities, at least one of whom has a disability and whose income, as hereinafter defined, is limited by reason of such disability:

<u>Income Levels</u>	<u>Percentage of Exemption</u>
Up to \$32,000	50%
\$32,001 - \$33,000	45%
\$33,001 - \$34,000	40%
\$34,001 - \$35,000	35%
\$35,001 - \$35,900	30%
\$35,901 - \$36,800	25%
\$36,801 - \$37,700	20%

\$37,701 - \$38,600	15%
\$38,601 - \$39,500	10%
\$39,501 - \$40,000	5%
\$40,001 and over	0%

Section 3: Except as herein amended, the provisions of Article V of Chapter 139 of the Town Code of the Town of Brunswick, which provides for a Disabled Homeowner Tax Exemption in the Town of Brunswick, shall continue in full force and effect.

Section 4: This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Office of the Secretary of State of the State of New York.
