**Board Members Present:** Supervisor Herrington, Councilman Christian, Councilman Cipperly, Councilman Balistreri, and Councilman Sullivan.

**Also Present:** Town Attorney, Dave Gruenberg, and Town Clerk, Alicia Saunders.

Supervisor Herrington called the meeting to order at 7:08 p.m.

The purpose of the meeting was to hold a Public Hearing to accept public comment on A Local Law Amending the Zoning Law of the Town of Brunswick and the Zoning Map of the Town of Brunswick to Rezone Tax Map Parcel Nos. 83.-4-12.2, 83.-4-12.12, 93.-3.2, and 93.3-3 from the Agricultural (A-40) Zoning District to the Industrial Heavy (IND-H) Zoning District.

At Supervisor Herrington's request, the Town Clerk read the complete Notice of Public Hearing into record. The Notice had been posted on the Town website, the Town Hall bulletin board and published in Troy Record. This Notice was also mailed to the Grafton Town Clerk along with all adjacent land owners.

**VISITORS WHO WISH TO SPEAK:**

*Mary Beth Ellen*, Cooper Ave, Troy, asked if there were any homes along where the mine was going to expand and questions regarding the effect it would have on homes in the future 10-20 years from now. Mr. Valenti informed that the closest home was 944ft from the expansion of the mine. While also confirming that he spoke with the gentlemen who was present at the meeting, currently in the process of building the home and the owner was assured that there is a 50-90 ft elevation from where the home was being built. There was no complaint regarding the expansion. There were also questions regarding noise and dust from the mine to which Mr. Valenti confirmed this would not be an issue and there would be no changes and everything would be contained inside of the mine.

Supervisor Herrington made a motion to keep public comment open for 10 days following the public hearing. Mr. Gruenberg informed that if anyone had any comments or concerns during that period to send correspondence to the Town Clerks office and all correspondence if any would be sent to the Town Board.

**ADJOURNMENT:**

Councilman Christian made a motion to close the public hearing, seconded by Councilman. Unanimously approved. The public hearing closed at 7:17 p.m.
