Supervisor Herrington called the meeting to order at 6:45 p.m. The purpose of the meeting was to hold a Public Hearing to accept public comment on Introductory Local Law No. 3 of 2022. The purpose of this proposed introductory local law is to make the Disabled Homeowner Tax Exemption on real property in the Town of Brunswick, as provided for in Article V of Chapter 139 of the Town Code of the Town of Brunswick, available to additional taxpayers, as is authorized by New York State Real Property Tax Law, Section 459-c.

Supervisor Herrington asked the Town Clerk to read the complete Notice of Public Hearing into the record. The Notice had been posted on the Town Website, the Town Hall bulletin board and published in The Eastwick Press.

Ms. Julie Irick, Sole Assessor, explained that this Local Law, if adopted, would amend section 139-12 of the Town Code, to extend the eligibility for the Disabled Homeowner Tax Exemption to more residents. The current income threshold (cap) allowing disabled homeowners to receive a tax exemption is \$34,400.00. If adopted, the Local Law would raise this to \$37,400.00. This also would align with the income limits set by Rensselaer County.

Supervisor Herrington opened the Public Hearing.
